

Into that heaven of freedom, my Father, let my country awake.





Objectives

Pursuit of the Jiwaji University's mission of teaching, research and service to the Society requires a shared commitment to the core values of the University as well as a commitment to the ethical conduct of all University activities. In that spirit, *the objectives* are a statement of our belief in ethical, legal and professional behavior in all of our dealings inside and outside the University.

The main objectives and strategies of the ethics and values policy for faculty members, staff and students are as follows:

Strategies for Faculty and Staff:

- Procedural Fairness: Members of the University fraternity are expected to conduct themselves ethically, honestly and with integrity in all dealings. The principles of fairness, good faith and respect consistent with laws, regulations and University policies govern our conduct with others both inside and outside the community.
- Responsibility: Each individual is expected to conduct and perform his/her duties in accordance with the core values and ethics, exercising sound judgment and serving the best interests of the Institution and the Community.
- Conformity to Laws and Regulations: Members of the University community are expected to become familiar with the laws and regulations bearing on their areas of responsibility. University dealings are to be conducted in conformance with legal requirements, including contractual commitments undertaken by individuals authorized to bind the University to such commitments.
- Commitment: Members of the University are expected to devote primary professional allegiance to the University and to the mission of teaching, research and service to the society.

- Ethical Conduct of Research: All members of the University engaged in research are expected to conduct their research with integrity and intellectual honesty at all times and with appropriate regard for human and animal subjects. Members of the University engaged in research are not to: fabricate data or results; change or knowingly omit data or results to misrepresent results in the research record; or intentionally misappropriate the ideas, writings, research, or findings of others. All those engaged in research are expected to pursue the advancement of knowledge while meeting the highest standards of honesty, accuracy, and objectivity. They are also expected to demonstrate accountability for sponsors' funds and to comply with specific terms and conditions of contracts and grants.
- Use of University Resources: University resources may only be used for activities on behalf of the University. They may not be used for private gain or personal purposes, except in limited circumstances permitted by existing policy where incidental personal use does not conflict with and is reasonable in relation to University duties. Members of the University community are expected to treat University property with care and to adhere to laws, policies and procedures for the use, maintenance, record keeping and disposal of University property.

Strategies for Students:

- Leadership: The University is dedicated to student success by preparing learners to be ethical leaders for a diverse and globally competitive workforce. The University is committed to enhancing the cultural and economic development of the State, Nation and World.
- Academic Integrity: Academic integrity is the foundation for excellence. The students are expected to work with full devotion, trust, sincerity and mutual respect.
- Ethical behavior: Students should strive to do what is honest and ethical even if no one is watching them or compelling them to 'Do the right thing'
- **Punctuality:** Students should be prompt, punctual and sincere towards their assignments.
- Perseverance: Students should work hard by following 3D's i.e. determination, devotion and dedication to enhance their global competency and urge to recognize challenges as opportunities.
- Fraternity: Students must create friendly atmosphere and should work together to achieve common goals.



Implementation Pathways

To fulfill all the standard core values, following measures will be taken up

- To create Ethics and Values cell.
- To acquaint the faculty, staff and students with the literature of ethics and values.
- To organize extension lectures/ workshops/ seminars/ training programmes for faculties, staff and students annually.
- To introduce value based courses in the curriculum.
- To organize value based programmes/activities through NSS.
- To create ethical environment which inculcates the feeling of human values.
