It shall withdraw the case and may:

- Either dispose of the case itself, or
- Determine the said question of law and return the case to the court from which the case has been so withdrawn together with a copy of its judgment on such question.
- And the said court shall on receipt thereof proceed to dispose of the case in conformity with such judgment.

Transfer of a Judge from one High Court to another-

Article 222-

- The President may, after consultation with the Chief Justice of India, transfer a Judge from one High Court to any other High Court.
- When a Judge has been or is so transferred, he shall during the period he serves.
- After the commencement of the Constitution (fifteenth Amendment) Act, 1963, as a Judge of the other High Court.
- Be entitled to receive in addition to his salary such compensatory allowance as may be determined by Parliament by law and
- Until so determined, such compensatory allowance as the President may by order fix.

Transfer of certain cases to High Court

Article 228-

If the High Court is satisfied that a case pending in a court subordinate to it involves a substantial question of law as to the interpretation of this Constitution the determination of which is necessary for the disposal of the case.
