

6. Any other item


The Coordinator thanked everyone for attending the meeting. The next meeting would be held on 03-12-2019.

Action taken on the resolutions passed on IQAC meeting No.14 held on 24th October, 2018.


S.No.	Issues	Action Taken
1.	Status of construction of Multi Art Complex	Main auditorium, conference hall, open air theatre, art gallery and surrounding garden are in final stage of completion.
2.	Introduction of SWAYAM/MOOC courses	Prof. GBKS Prasad informed that the Centre for Food Technology shall be adopting a 'MOOC' Course in Food Microbiology as part of 1 st semester course of M.Sc. Food Technology for the academic year 2019-20.
3.	Establishment of Translational Research & Ayurveda Health Centre	Prof. G. B. K. S. Prasad informed the members about the product-oriented research activities which are underway at the 'Centre for Translational Research'. Also, he informed about the prototype products prepared by the Centre. He informed that a proposal for setting up of 'Technology Incubator' based on prototype health care products is underway to Department of Science & Technology, New Delhi. Dr. Prasad informed that a proposal for separate allocation of research budget for promotion of product oriented translational research by Centre for Translational Research from the financial year 2019-20 onwards.

4.	Implementation of University Management System (UMS)	The Registrar informed that computerization of examination and account section have been started and will slowly be extended to other modules to make the University fully digitalized.
5.	Setting up of Academic Cells	The Registrar informed that as per the guidelines of IQAC, nine Academic Cells and Centres viz. Entrepreneurship Cell, Skill Development Cell, Information Technology Cell, Centre for Trace Element Studies, Centre for Yoga and Meditation, Placement Cell, Centre for Tribal Studies, Centre for Anandam and Centre for Innovation have been set up and made functional.



7. Any other item




Action Taken Report

1.	Launch of University News Letter	The IQAC Coordinator informed that as per the guidelines of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Prof. Mohapatra & Dr. Sameer have been given the task to publish the 'Newsletter' and the needful is being done.
2.	Promotion of Institutional and Industrial Collaborations	At the Initiative of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Memoranda of Understanding (MoUs) have been developed with about 15 Industrial houses and Universities in order to strengthen the inter-Institutional collaboration for strengthening of academics. The Tie ups with Industrial houses are meant for development and promotion of industry-oriented curricula and research. Hon'ble Vice Chancellor informed that one International MoU with 'Global Ayurveda Academy', USA has been signed and efforts are on to develop MoUs with International organizations.
3.	Performance Evaluation Report	The Committee examined the PER received from various departmental Heads/Coordinators and suggested remedial measures for strengthening of academics.
